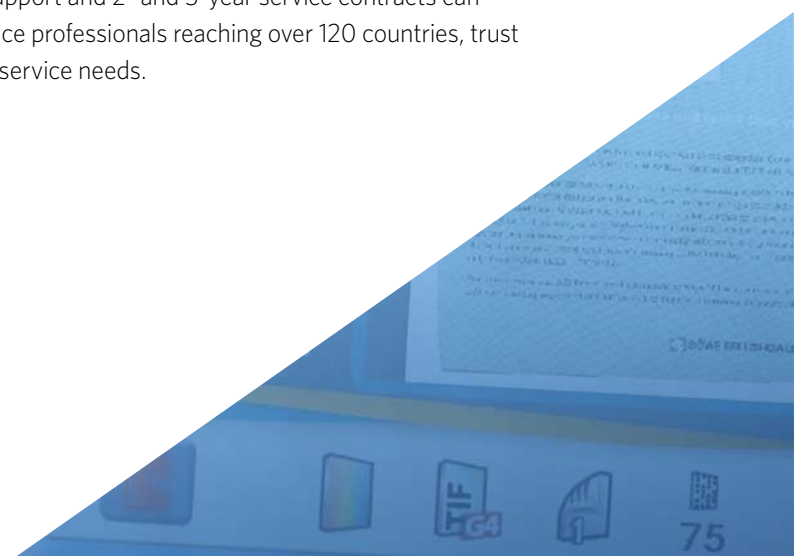
- Create JPEG files at 300, 600, or 1,200 dpi
